

**The Book of Hebrews**  
**Chapter 10 verses 19 – 25 - Pastor Charles A. Hall – October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**Chapter 10 verse 19 to 25** The focus point of discussion in this chapter is that Jesus Christ is a once for all sacrifice. The first point of truth concerning the once for all sacrifice is highlighted by contrast, the need for a repetitious sacrifice each year for service by the Mosaic system. On the other hand, the sacrifice that Christ offered up was a one-time sacrifice and is made complete by His continuing position and priesthood role as our intermediary, who is seated on the right hand of God. The result is where there is a remission (the act of absolving or taking away), and deliverance (set free) there is no more need for an offering for sin. In the later verses in this chapter the author continues to encourage believers to be faithful!

19. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

Because of the work of Christ, and the blood sacrifice that He made on our behalf as our high priest, now as believers we have complete confidence that we can enter into the holiest of Holies, and in the presence of God.

- Ephesians 2:18

20. By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

As a result of the work and sacrifice of Christ, believers now by a new and different covenant, are allowed to enter the Holiest of Holy, beyond the veil (curtains) by a new and living way, which has been consecrated (declared and set aside) for believers.

- John 14:6

21. And having an high priest over the house of God;

This verse is a follow on from the prior verse and confirms that we are allowed to enter the holiest of Holy and into the presence of God only by our High Priest Jesus Christ, who is the ruler over the house of God.

22. Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Because of the sacrifice of Christ, and His active Priesthood (divine ministry) as ruler over God's house, we should draw near to God with confidents and complete assurance. Having been cleansed by His blood.

23. Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

Our faith, unwavering confidence and belief in the work and ministry of Christ, should encourage us to be steadfast, and to trust Him and His promises.

24. And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

As a result of what God has done for us through His Son Jesus Christ, we should be motivated to be respectful and caring of each other, and encourage each other with love, and good works.

25. Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

This verse continues to expound the prior verse and states that we should not only respect, care, and encourage each other, but we should also come together as one body in unity and fellowship to further encourage each other, especially as the day of Christ's return is quickly approaching.
