• <u>Trust means:</u> From a biblical standpoint the word "Trust" means to believe in the reliability, truth, ability, and strength of something. So, when it comes to trusting God, we can accept without wavering that He is dependable, His Words are true, His abilities are unlimited, His strength is unmeasurable. The bible states that God cannot lie. He always keeps His promises. God loves His creation (human beings), and He has good things in store for us!

We have devoted a lot of time to ensure that we know how to communicate with God and how to decern God's direction and influence from that of the world. As a result of knowledge that we have gained about God, we should be in a position to place greater trust in Him and in His ability to do everything that He says He can do, as well as deliver on all His promises. It is easy to say that we trust God, but it is a lot more difficult to put this into practice when we consider all of the pressure and influences that fills our mind on a daily basis. When things and events in our life are going well then it is easy to trust God, but when life starts to be a little challenging it become a little more difficult to place our trust in God. - <u>Proverbs 3:5-6</u> (5) Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. (6) In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
- <u>Matthew 19:26</u> But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.
- <u>Jeremiah 32:17</u> Ah Lord GoD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee:

When we place our trust in God, we must wait patiently on God, for his timing is different that ours, and His ways are different as well. God moves according to His own time, not ours. • <u>Isaiah 55: 8-9</u> (8) For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. (9) For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

When we wait on God patiently and seek him through our spirit filled prayers, the spirit of God will help us in our time of weakness, even if we do not know what we should be asking God for. The spirit of God that is within believers will make nonverbal sounds as the spirit searches our hearts, and the spirit will intercede on behalf of God, in accordance with His divine will.

• Romans 8:25-27 (25) But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it.
